## **RE: THE NEW YOUTH AND COMMUNITY BUILDING**

As the village seems to be growing rapidly and new houses usually means young families and children, it is more imperative than ever that the Parish Council needs to plan for future expansion of the Parish. Adults are well catered for at the Fulbourn Centre and the new Sports Hall both owned and run by the Townley Trust and now is the time to increase provision for the youth who are currently in cramped, dilapidated premises which are no longer fit for purpose. As some of you will know the Parish Council has been trying to raise the money to provide a new youth and community building with an office and two meeting rooms for some years now.

Half the funds for a new building have been raised and Council is holding a Public Meeting to consult with parishioners on its proposal to apply for a short term loan to raise the rest of the building costs as it usually means a small increase in the Parish element of your Council Tax. Fulbourn's precept is one of the lowest in South Cambridgeshire and the Parish Council will do all it can to keep costs to a minimum.
