

Fulbourn Village History Society Archive Collection Includes:

Computer software for both our Accessions database and for Family History Research.

Artefacts mostly relating to social history.

Press Cuttings from local newspapers and magazines on topics with links to Fulbourn dating from the 1980's to the present.

Maps and Reference books on the history, geology, architecture, archaeology etc. of the local area. About 120 are available on loan (including the Fulbourn Chronicles).

Over 5000 Photographs associated with Fulbourn (from the 1870's to the present day). They are stored in folders for reference and have also been digitalised, which can improve legibility.

Register of Electors and Census Returns (1841-1901) for Fulbourn available as hard copies. Census details for the years 1841,1851, 1871 and 1881 (1891 forthcoming) are also on a computer database which makes it easier to search for information.

Lists of names on the Fulbourn War Memorial and on headstones in St Vigor's and United Reformed churchyards.

Copies of Draft (1806) and Final (1814) Enclosure Map of Fulbourn Parish. They have also been digitalised.

Extracts from Fulbourn Parish Minute Book (1859-1990)

Transcriptions of Wills drawn up by Fulbourn inhabitants, dating from the 16th century.

A survey by English Heritage of Ancient buildings in Fulbourn, compiled in 1951.
