GENERAL INFORMATION

The name of Fulbourn is derived from the Anglo-Saxon 'Fugolburna' meaning 'A stream frequented by birds'

Area 5270 acres. Population 4732 (2001 Census)

Recreation Ground Home End Children's play area and facilities for football, cricket, tennis, bowls and netball.

Dogs Dogs must be kept on a lead on the Recreation Ground. Bins for dog excreta are positioned at all entrances to the ground: - Home End, Impetts Lane, Stonebridge Lane and Balsham Road.
